MBA POLYMERS AWARDED FIRST THOMAS ALVA EDISON AWARD FOR INNOVATION

Richmond, Calif., March 25, 2002- MBA Polymers, Inc. (MBA), a company that facilitates the recycling of electronics equipment, today announced that it has been awarded the first Thomas Alva Edison Award for Innovation by The Young Entrepreneurs Organization (YEO) and the Edison Preservation Foundation. The award recognizes MBA's pioneering of the recycling of high value plastics from end-of-life durable goods such as appliances, business equipment, computers, electronics and automobiles.
